
UPON THE APPLICATION of the Plaintiff, Caroline Breton; AND UPON reading the Affidavit of Caroline Breton, affirmed November 6, 2022; AND UPON hearing from Class Counsel and Counsel for the Defendants;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Settlement Agreement, as exhibited at Exhibit 'A' to the Affidavit of Caroline Breton, affirmed November 6, 2022 ("**Settlement Agreement**"), is approved, pursuant to section 35 of


the *Class Proceedings Act*, SA 2003, C-16.5, as fair, reasonable and in the best interests of the Class;

2. The Settlement Agreement shall be implemented in accordance with its terms;
3. The Settlement Agreement binds the parties and the Class Members, including those persons or estates that may require litigation representatives;
4. The requirements of Rules 2.11 and 2.18 are hereby waived;
5. The plan for the distribution of net settlement proceeds as set out at Section 7 of the Settlement Agreement is approved as fair and appropriate. The net settlement proceeds shall be distributed in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement;
6. The Parties shall agree and seek an Order of the Court appointing a claims administrator in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement within 30 days of the date of the Effective Date (as defined in the Settlement Agreement);
7. The Parties may, on notice to the Court, but without the need for further Order of the Court, agree to reasonable extensions of time to carry out any of the provisions of the Settlement Agreement;
8. Upon the Effective Date, the Releasors will have released and discharged the Releasees from the Released Claims in accordance with Section 9 of the Settlement Agreement; and
9. Upon the Effective Date, the Action against the Defendants is dismissed, without costs.


