Further to the above-noted Action and our correspondence of August 19, 2025, please find enclosed the Addendum to Final Report to the Court and to the Class, filed on February 18, 2026.

As noted in the Final Report, the Addendum was to be filed once the Claims Administrator had confirmed all payments to the Class Members cleared and the data destruction was complete. The Addendum confirms all payments to the Class Members and a cy-près award made to the Luna Child and Youth Advocacy Center pursuant to section 6.4(A) of the Settlement Agreement.

However, in light of recent correspondence from one Class Member who has requested all data from administration of the claims process be preserved, we confirm that the Claims Administrator has held off on the data destruction. This Class Member previously contacted you on January 8, 2025, and expressed their dissatisfaction with the claims process and the outcome.

This Class Member has contacted us recently again regarding his concerns. As such, we are seeking the advice and direction of the Court.

Enclosed is a proposed Order to direct the Claims Administrator to complete the destruction of all data related to the administration of this matter, as contemplated by the settlement and prior Court direction to bring this matter to a close. Specifically, all electronic data is to be securely destroyed in-house. The Claims Administrator has confirmed no paper records were received.

In light of the Class Member's stated concerns, we are seeking advice and direction from the Court as to whether the Claims Administrator can proceed with the data destruction pursuant to the proposed Order, or whether an appearance before the Court would be of assistance. Should

you believe a hearing is necessary to address this matter, or any other matters, kindly confirm and we will make arrangements for the same.

We confirm that a copy of this letter and proposed Order is being provided directly to the Class Member who has requested the data be preserved, and will be posted on Class Counsel's website for broader notice to the Class, as we have done in the past.
